	Introduction to the Supply Chain Concept	
1	The facilitator helps explain the concept of a supply chain and its components:	
	Example: Supplier → Manufacturer → Distributor → Retailer → Customer	
	Discuss examples of supply chains for products familiar to students (e.g., soft drinks, fast food, clothing).	
	Identifying the Company's Supply Chain	
	Direct the Chief & logistics team members to map out the process from procurement to product delivery to customers, based on their business model.	
	Use the following guiding questions:	
2	 Where do the product's raw materials come from? (if selling physical products) 	
	 Who produces the goods or provides the services? 	
	 How are stocks stored or managed? 	
	 How are products/services distributed to customers? 	
	Use the Supply Chain Map template to visualize the process flow.	
	Analyzing Supply Chain Efficiency	
	Students are asked to analyze several aspects, such as:	
	 Are suppliers easily accessible and quick in delivery? 	
3	 Is production or service delivery on time? 	
	 Are there risks in the distribution process? 	
	 Which parts of the process consume the most time or cost? 	
	Record the analysis results in the vendor list notes created in the previous module.
