	Understanding Financial Statements		
	The Chiefs of Finance & Accounting guide department members to prepare the financial statement format available on the VCI Portal.		
	Learn that a basic financial statement consists of:		
1	 Balance Sheet – Prepared to show the financial position of a company at a specific period. The balance sheet is typically compiled annually and is essential for determining the company's value after financial activities. 		
	 Cash Flow Statement – Contains information about cash inflows and outflows during the reporting period. It records the timing of transactions and reflects historical changes in cash. 		
	3. Income Statement – Shows the difference between revenue and expenses. This report helps inform decision-making and serves as a benchmark, for example, in measuring return on investment or earnings per share.

	To compile financial statements, collect transaction data from the beginning of transactions using the following records: 1. Cash Receipt and Cash Payment Journal
